The HIRE Hour

One idea that developed during the discussions at the HGS-HIRE Graduate Day was a regular, online platform, where on a regular basis, once a month, as a 'HGS-HIRE jour fix' **individual experiences or recommendations with technical tools, procedures or techniques** can be shared and discussed. Rather than trying to provide in every session an all-embracing summary with the claim to demonstrate the ultimate wisdom on a certain topic, the format shall give room for individual perspectives where certain topics can be discussed or presented. Over time different views on perspectives on certain topics may emerge. An important ingredient to this measure is a growing archive of presentations for reference and future support. We tried to summarise 'The HIRE Hour' as **brief, regular, individual views from life**.

The HGS-HIRE Hour is planned once a month, **every first Thursday at 16:00**.

In a 30 minute pitch presentation, invited experts or experienced doctoral students from HGS-HIRE share their individual experience, advice or recommendation on the topic of the month. The introductory presentation is followed by a 30-60 minute question and discussion session as needed. Previous presentations will be found in the "The HIRE Hour" archive. "The HIRE Hour" is online only, no registration needed, just zoom in.
